(1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$35,518.00, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$73,993.00. (2) For the 2007 levy year, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single-family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$12.00. (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2007 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).	Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Mahomet Public Library District, Champaign County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .08% above the limiting rate for levy year 2006 and be equal to .2816 of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011? (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$372, 549, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$520,386. (2) For the 2008 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$26.67. (3) Based upon an average annual percentage increase in the market value of such property of 4.34%, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against such property for the 2009 levy year is estimated to be \$30.74, for the 2010 levy year is estimated to be \$34.99 and for the 2011 levy year is estimated to be \$39.43. (4) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
