AFFIDAVIT OF MARK MOSSMAN

Mark Mossman, being first duly sworn states:

1. My name is Mark Mossman. I am the Director of the Division of Election Information at the State Board of Elections. I am over 18 years of age. I have personal knowledge of the statements contained herein, and if called to testify would be competent to testify to the same.
2. All mailed or in-person filings of Resolutions to Fill Vacancies in Nomination and/or Certificates of Organization are supposed to be directed to the staff in the Election Information Division.
3. Upon receipt, the Resolutions are checked to ensure that they are being filed in the correct location, in the correct time frame, and for an office where a vacancy exists.
4. If an attempted filing is not in the correct location, is not being filed in the correct time frame, or is not for an office where a vacancy exists, then the Resolution is not accepted for filing.
5. If a Certificate of Organization of the managing or nominating committee accompanies the filing of the Resolution, a copy of it is stored with the Resolution. Any responses to requests for copies of the Resolution include the relevant Certificate of Organization, if one has been filed.
