PROPOSED CALL FOR AN ILLINOIS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

You will vote a ballot that includes a referendum titled "PROPOSED CALL FOR AN ILLINOIS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION". The ballot contains an "Explanation of Proposed Call" that a court has ruled is inaccurate and incorrect and should be ignored.

You should disregard the language on the ballot, read the explanation below and at the **END** of your ballot vote your intention after the words "For the calling of a Constitutional Convention."

PROPOSED CALL FOR AN ILLINOIS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

EXPLANATION OF A PROPOSED CALL

This proposal deals with a call for a state Constitutional Convention. The last such convention was held in 1969-1970, and a new Constitution was adopted in 1970. The 1970 Illinois Constitution requires that the question of calling a convention be placed before the voters every 20 years. If you support the calling of a Constitutional Convention, vote "YES." If you oppose the calling of a Constitutional Convention, vote "NO."
