

**BUDGET AND ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE BEMONT PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF PLATT AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2007**

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Bemont Public Library District, of the County of Platt, State of Illinois, has prepared or caused to be prepared a tentative form of the Annual Budget and Appropriation for said Public Library District, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007 and the same has been conveniently available for public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon; and WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as to such Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance on September 19, 2006 notice of which was published thereon in the News Record, a newspaper of general circulation in the Bemont Public Library District;

WHEREAS, all other legal requirements have been duly complied with by the Board of Trustees of the Bemont Public Library District;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BEMONT PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF PLATT AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the fiscal year of the Bemont Public Library be, and the same hereby fixed and declared to be from July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007.

Section 2: That the following budget, containing in Part I and estimate of the receipts of the General Library Fund and the proposed appropriations for the fiscal year July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007 and in Part II, the proposed tentative Budget and Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the Bemont Public Library District for library purposes for the fiscal year as hereinabove set forth, from the General Library Fund in Part II of

Section 2 above.

The secretary of the Bemont Public Library District is hereby authorized and directed to have this Ordinance published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the library district.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
