~~During construction of a new gymnasium at the Gifford Grade School campus, a 6,000 gallon pre-1974 heating oil tank was discovered underground. There had been no expectation that an abandoned tank would be located directly under the foundation of the new construction. Not removing the tank could cause foundation failure in the future. Several options were discussed. It was decided to remove the oil tank and the contaminated soil around the tank. The State Fire Marshall determined that an "incident report" had to be filed. He also directed that the contaminated materials must be disposed of in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. It is estimated this entire process will cost at least \$15,000 when complete. Sufficient Health/Life/Safety funds are available for this project.~~

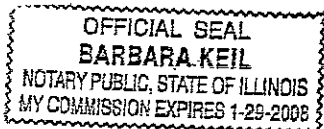
