**ORDINANCE NO. 04-1201**

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP  
PURPOSES FOR CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP,  
CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS  
FOR THE TAX YEAR 2004, COLLECTIBLE IN 2005**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF  
CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of Four Hundred and One Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$401,000.00) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes as:

- General Town Fund
- General Assistance Fund
- Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund
- Social Security Fund

for the year 2005.

Section 2. That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:



Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.



ORDINANCE NO 1104-01

COMPENSATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, section 9 of the Illinois Constitution 1970, the compensation of an elected Township official may not be increased or decreased during the official's term of office, Ill. Const. Art VII. Sec. 9 (1970); and

WHEREAS, the positions of Supervisor, Township Trustees and Assessor of the Town of the City of Champaign Township (Township) are elective positions within the meaning of Article VII, Section 9 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, Ill. Const. Art. VII Sec. 9 (1970); and

WHEREAS, the positions of Supervisor and Assessor of the Township will be voted upon at the consolidated election to be held on April 5, 2005; and

WHEREAS, new terms of office for the positions of Supervisor and Township Trustees of the Township are due to commence on May 2, 2005, and new term of office for the position of Assessor of the Township is due to commence on January 1, 2006, 60 Illinois Compiled Statutes 1/50; and

WHEREAS, said terms of office are for four (4) years duration, 60 Illinois Compiled Statutes 1/50-15; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Town Trustees of the Township must establish the compensation for each new term of office at least 180 days prior to the beginning of the term of such office, 50 Illinois Compiled Statutes 145/2.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP as follows:

Section 1. That the compensation for the Supervisor, Township Trustees and Assessor of the Township for their respective upcoming terms of office is fixed and established at the following amounts:


Section 2. That the compensation herein above provided for shall be paid to the Supervisor and Assessor of the Township in equal monthly installments during the year in which such compensation is paid.

Section 3. That, in addition to the compensation herein above provided, the Supervisor and Assessor of the Township shall be provided health insurance on the same terms and conditions provided heretofore, namely such insurance as is provided to City of Champaign employees, with the premium for individual coverage and, if selected, one-half of the family coverage paid by the Township and one half of family coverage paid by the official.
