ORDINANCE NO. 2004-12-157

**ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING  
JULY 1, 2004 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2005 (REVISED)**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, pursuant to an ordinance previously adopted authorizing the same, did, on the 21st day of June, 2004, that date being before the beginning of the fiscal year of the city commencing on July 1, 2004, and ending on June 30, 2005, adopt the Annual Budget Ordinance for the city for such fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 8-2-9.1 et seq. of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.1 et seq.) and home rule ordinances previously adopted authorizing the same (Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, Sections 2-113 and 2-132), such passage of the Annual Budget Ordinance by the City Council shall be in lieu of passage of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance otherwise required by the Illinois Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the total maximum amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes, which are legally made to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana, is hereby ascertained to be the sum of Five Million, Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars (\$5,812,393).

Section 2. That the sum of Five Million, Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars (\$5,812,393) being the total of budgeted appropriations heretofore legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for all corporate purposes of said City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby levied upon all

of the taxable property in the City of Urbana, Illinois, subject to taxation for the current year.

The specific amounts as levied for the various funds heretofore named are separately included herein by being placed in separate columns under the heading "To Be Raised by Tax Levy" which appears over the same, the tax so levied being for the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana and for the said budgeted appropriation to be collected from said tax levy, the total of which has been ascertained as aforesaid and being as follows:

Section 3. This Annual Tax Levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code; provided, however, that any tax rate limitation or any other substantive limitations as to tax levies in the Illinois Municipal Code in conflict with this ordinance shall not be applicable to this ordinance pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

Section 4. That there is hereby certified to the County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois, the several sums aforesaid, constituting said total amount of Five Million, Eight Hundred Twelve Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety Three Dollars (\$5,812,393), which said total amount the City of Urbana requires to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of the City, and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana is hereby ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of Champaign County on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 5. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application of such provisions to any circumstances is held invalid for any reason whatsoever, the remainder of this ordinance or the application of the provisions to other circumstances shall not be affected hereby.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately on and after its passage and approval, and furthermore, upon the filing of a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk, the prior levy ordinance (Ordinance No. 2004-11-150) is repealed.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said council.

**A REVISED RESOLUTION  
DIRECTING THE CHAMPAIGN COUNTY CLERK  
TO ABATE THE TAX LEVY FOR THE GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSE  
FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2004 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2005**

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, is a home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare, to license, to tax and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has determined that an appropriate total tax levy rate for the City of Urbana for the year beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2005, is \$1.3120.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Champaign County Clerk abate the general corporate purpose levy of \$1,597,922 in Ordinance No. 2004-12-157, in an amount necessary to produce a levy of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ for the year beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2005.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is directed to determine, based on final information from the Champaign County Clerk, the exact dollar amount which, when extended, will produce an overall tax rate of \$1.3120 for the total City of Urbana tax levy for the year beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2005, and to insert such number into Section 1 of this Resolution, if the levy of \$1,597,922 for general corporate purposes would produce a overall final tax rate of more than \$1.3120.

**Section 3. Home Rule Exercise.** That this Resolution is enacted pursuant to and as an exercise of the City of Urbana's Home Rule Powers under the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois.

**Section 4.** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution, completed as provided for in Section 2, with the County Clerk of Champaign County immediately after the Resolution is completed.

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE


