TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 04-4

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for Condit Township, Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Condit Township, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of *Thirty-three thousand five hundred sixty-seven and 52/100* Dollars (\$33,567.52) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

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TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Condit Township Town Fund, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

ORDINANCE NO. 04-5

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Condit Road District, Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Condit Township, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Condit Road District on December 13, 2004, does hereby determine and declare that the sum of Seventy-seven thousand seventy-one and 80/100 Dollars (\$77,071.80) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:



SECTION 4: That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for Condit Road District.




