An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for Crittenden Township ,
Champaign County, Illinois for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Crittenden Township, Champaign
County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the the sum of---SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND FOUR
HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE---Dollars (\$61,439.00) are hereby levied upon all property
subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in
order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as
required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Crittenden Township, Champaign County, Illinois as follows:
