**LEVY ORDINANCE OF
HOMER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR THE
REVENUE YEAR 2003**

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF HOMER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT IN THE COUNTIES OF CHAMPAIGN AND VERMILION, STATE OF ILLINOIS:

That there is hereby levied by the Homer Fire Protection District for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2004, and ending April 30, 2005, the total sum of \$116,974.00 on the property subject to taxation within said Fire Protection District at the equalized assessed value said amount being required by the Homer Fire Protection District for the particular objects and purposes hereinafter specified and as previously appropriated in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of said Fire Protection District which has been duly adopted and published as provided by law, said particular objects and purposes being as follows:

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TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Homer Fire Protection District, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 1.9% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The *proposed* aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The adopted aggregate tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount state in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law".
