CHAMPAIGN COUNTY CLERK

An Ordinance levying taxes for the LUDLOW Township, Champaign County, State of Illinois for the tax year 2004 collectible in 2005.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of LUDLOW Township, Champaign Country, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the sum of \$96,049.00 is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the township as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- A. GENERAL TOWN FUND
- B. GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUND
- C. CEMETERY FUND

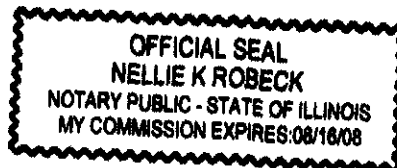

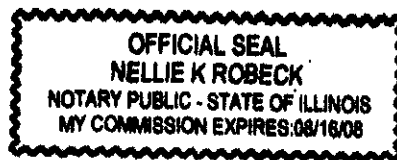
