For the levy and assessment of taxes for the OGDEN-ROYAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, located in the counties of Champaign and Vermilion, State of Illinois.

In pursuance of authority vested in them by "an act in relation to Fire Protection Districts", the Board of Trustees in meeting assembled do hereby find and declare that there will be required to be raised by taxation the amounts hereinafter set down to be levied upon all taxable property in said District, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the District, as required by statute in accordance with the law, and the amounts so required are itemized and needed for uses and purposes as follows:



TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the OGDEN-ROYAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation Act."

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The proposed aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held.
