An Ordinance levying taxes for the OGDEN-STANTON MULTI-TOWNSHIP ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, Champaign County, State of Illinois.

Now be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the OGDEN-STANTON MULTI-TOWNSHIP ASSESSMENT DISTRICT in meeting assembled, that we do hereby find and declare that there will be required to be raised by general taxation the amount herein set down, to be levied upon all taxable property in said Multi-Township Assessment District, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Multi-Township Assessment District as required by statute, the amounts so required are itemized and needed for used and purposes as follows, to wit:

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Ogden-Stanton Multi-Township Assessment District, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 1.9% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The *proposed* aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The adopted aggregate tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount state in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law".
