TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 2004-04

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for PHILO Township,
CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of PHILO Township,
CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of Eighty Three Thousand Nine Hundred and no Cents
 Dollars (\$ 83,900) are hereby levied upon
all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized,
in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required
by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- GENERAL TOWN FUND, SOCIAL SECURITY,
- GENERAL ASSISTANCE,
- AUDIT,
- LIABILITY INSURANCE,

for the year 2003.



TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Philo Township, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-05Road

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for PHILO Road District,
CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of PHILO Township,
CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of PHILO Road District on
DECEMBER 7th, 2004, does hereby determine and declare that the sum of Two Hundred
Fifty Six Thousand Three Hundred Sixty and no Cent Dollars (\$256,360.00) are hereby leived
upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and
equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District
as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:
