ORDINANCE No. _____

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for RAYMOND Township,

CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, for the tax year 2004, collectable in 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of RAYMOND Township,

CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, as follows:
