AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWN PURPOSES FOR THE Urbana  
TOWNSHIP, Champaign COUNTY, ILLINOIS  
for the Year ~~2004~~ collectable in ~~2005~~.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF Urbana  
Township Champaign COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of One Hundred Thirty Eight thousand  
Dollars (\$ 138,000) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the township as that property is assessed  
and equalized for the current year, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the township as  
required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law. Taxes are levied for such purposes as
