AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE 2004-2005 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees on June 14, 2004, passed and approved the Village's Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, Ordinance No. 04-06-02 (the "Appropriation Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees, in accordance with and pursuant to The Truth in Taxation Act, not less than 20 days before the date of adoption of this tax levy ordinance, on October 11, 2004, after adoption of the Appropriation Ordinance, determined the amounts of money, exclusive of election costs required by the general election law, estimated to be raised by taxation for the 2004-2005 fiscal year upon the taxable property in the Village, such amounts being not to exceed the hereinafter defined maximum tax extension amount; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have projected that revenues with respect to the several amounts set forth in the Appropriation Ordinance are estimated (with a \$26,952.56 general fund balance on May 10, 2004, and a \$83,915.06 motor fuel tax fund balance on May 10, 2004) as follows: Illinois Income Tax, \$27,000.00; Illinois Personal Property Replacement Tax, \$1,100.00; Interest, \$1,500.00; Permits, \$150.00; Real Estate Tax, \$9,040.00; Retailer's Occupational Tax, \$4,000.00; Village Hall Rent, \$210.00; Franchise Fees; \$1,200.00; and Illinois Local Use Tax, 3,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the amounts required to be raised by taxation as aforesaid are not more than 105% of such amounts which have been extended upon the levy of the year preceding this year's levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDVILLE, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. General Corporate Levy.

That in addition to all other Village taxes levied there be and is hereby levied a tax, to the extent authorized by law and as herein provided, against all taxable property in the Village of Bondville, Champaign County, Illinois, to defray necessary expenses and liabilities of the Village and for such purposes and in such amounts, for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2004, and ending April 30, 2005, for general corporate purposes, as follows:

2. Municipal Auditing Tax.

That in addition to and in excess of all other Village taxes levied there be and is hereby levied a tax, to the extent authorized by law and as herein provided, against all taxable

property in the Village of Bondville, Champaign County, Illinois to defray necessary expenses of the Village for the audit and investigation of public accounts a Municipal Auditing Tax under Section 8-8-8 of the Illinois Municipal Code for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2004, and ending April 30, 2005, as follows:

3. Insurance Levy.

That in addition to and in excess of all other Village taxes levied there be and is hereby levied a tax, to the extent authorized by law and as herein provided, against all taxable property in the Village of Bondville, Champaign County, Illinois to defray necessary expenses of the Village for the purpose of purchasing insurance, purchasing claims services, or otherwise providing protection to the Village under Section 9-107 of the Local Governmental and Governmental Employees Tort Immunity Act for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2004, and ending April 30, 2005, as follows:

4. That the sum of the levies in paragraphs 1 through 3 above aggregate \$9,490.00 and the Village Clerk, or other appropriate officer, be and is hereby directed to file or cause to be filed a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a certified copy of Ordinance No. 04-06-02 (adopted June 14, 2004) with the Champaign County Clerk before the last Tuesday in December of this year (or such earlier time as required by law) and to obtain a receipt therefor.

5. That the Village has a population of less than 500, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

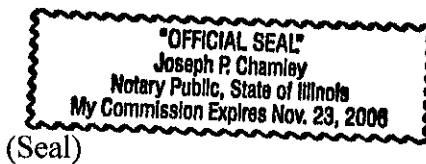


