LEVY ORDINANCE

VILLAGE OF BROADLANDS
2004 TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Broadlands in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois did heretofore duly adopt an Annual Appropriation Ordinance for said Village for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of May, 2004, which said Appropriation Ordinance was duly adopted and published within the time and manner required by statute.

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of said Village have now determined the amount to be collected from the Property Tax Levy for said fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Broadlands, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

That the sum of \$ 8,142.18 be and the same is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property in said Village, subject to taxation for the current year. The specific amounts levied for the various purposes being hereafter placed in a column under the heading "Amount Levied" and being placed opposite the specific purposes for which said levies are made.

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of VILLAGE OF BROADLANDS, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The *proposed* aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The *adopted* aggregate tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."
