

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Royal in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 7th day of June 2004 A. D. 2004, pass the annual appropriation bill for said Village for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of April 2004 A. D. 2004, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of seventy nine thousand Dollars, which said appropriation bill was duly posted on the 8th day of June 2004 A. D. 2004. Now, therefore,

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Royal Illinois:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said Village of Royal subject to taxation for the year, A. D. 19 04., the total sum of four thousand Dollars, for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Village of Royal, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.
