**Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase
for Bement Public Library District.**

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Bement Public Library District for tax year 2006 payable 2007 will be held on November 21 at 6:30 p.m. at the Bement Public Library District Conference Room, 349 S. Macon, Bement, Illinois 61813

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing District may contact Kenneth Wright, Treasurer, 533 S. Piatt, Bement, 217-678-8488.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2005 payable 2006 were \$55,496.50.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2006 payable 2007 are \$66,595.80. This represents a 20% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2005 payable 2006 were \$0.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission lease for 2006 payable 2007 are \$0. This represents a 0% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2005 payable 2006 were \$55,496.50.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2006 payable 2007 are \$66,595.80. This represents a 20% increase over the previous year.

NOTICE OF BEMENT PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT TO LEVY ADDITIONAL TAX AT A RATE OF .02 PERCENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Bement Public Library District, Platt and Champaign Counties, Illinois, that on July 25, 2006, the Board levied an additional tax for the 2006 tax year, payable in 2007, at the rate of .02 percent upon all the taxable property of the District at the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue.

If not less than 148 voters of the District sign a petition requesting that the question of the adoption of said additional tax levy be submitted to the voters of the District and the petition is filed not later

with the Secretary of the Library District, the question of the adoption of said tax levy shall be submitted to a referendum to be held at the March, 2006 General Primary Election. If no such Petition is filed with the Secretary of the Library District within thirty (30) days from the date of the adoption of such levy, then the Board of Trustees of the Bement Public Library District, Platt and Champaign Counties, shall be authorized to levy an additional tax at a rate of .02 percent.

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
