

**RESOLUTION REGARDING ESTIMATED AMOUNTS NECESSARY
TO BE LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2006**

WHEREAS, the Truth in Taxation Law requires that all taxing districts in the State of Illinois determine the estimated amounts of taxes necessary to be levied for the year not less than twenty (20) days prior to the official adoption of the aggregate tax levy of the district; and

WHEREAS, if the estimated aggregate amount necessary to be levied, exclusive of election costs and bond and interest costs, exceeds 105% of the aggregate amount of property taxes extended or estimated to be extended, including any amount abated by the taxing district prior to such extension, upon the levy of the preceding year, public notice shall be given and a public hearing shall be held on the district's intent to adopt a tax levy in an amount which is more than 105% of such extension or estimated extension for the preceding year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education, Bement Community Unit School District 5, County of Piatt, State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The aggregate amount of taxes estimated to be levied for the year 2006 is \$1,788,049.

Section 2: The aggregate amount of taxes estimated to be levied for the year 2006 does not exceed 105% of the taxes extended by the district in the year 2005.


Section 3: In light of Section 2 above, the provisions of sections 18-65 through 18-85 of the Truth in Taxation Law do not apply to the adoption of the 2006 aggregate levy, and the district is not required to publish notice of or conduct a hearing thereon.

Section 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ABATEMENT OF TAX
LEVIES FOR TAX YEAR 2006, PAYABLE IN 2007**

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Bement Community Unit School District No. 5, Piatt and Champaign Counties, Illinois, (hereinafter "District") is a local taxing district within the meaning of 35 ILCS 200/1-155. Further, said District has the authority to levy taxes pursuant to the *Illinois School Code*; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2006, the Board of Education adopted a levy authorizing and directing the respective county clerks to extend property tax based upon the adopted levied, to the maximum extent allowable under the law; and

WHEREAS, the District is a taxing district that receives funds under Section 12 of the State Revenue Sharing Act, 30 ILCS 115/12; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education hereby determines that it has surplus funds available and that it is deemed advisable to reduce its tax levy for tax year 2006, payable in 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Bement Community Unit School District No. 5, Piatt and Champaign Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The following tax levies shall be reduced to the amounts as more fully set forth below. All tax levies not otherwise specified shall hereby remain in full force and effect and as adopted by the Board of Education on December 13, 2006.

\$136,663	Liability Insurance (Tort) Fund
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SECTION 2: The Board President and Secretary are authorized to execute any and all documents needed to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 3: The Superintendent, or his designee, shall hereby deliver, as soon as practical, but in no event later than March 1, 2007, a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Clerks of Piatt and Champaign Counties, Illinois.

SECTION 4: Any resolution in conflict herewith shall be deemed null and void.
