BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BROADLANDS - LONGVIEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT in the Counties of Champaign and Douglas, State of Illinois, as follows:

1. There is hereby levied for the Revenue Year 2006 for the objects and purposes of the Broadlands - Longview Fire Protection District, as appropriated for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2006 - and ending March 31, 2007, the following amounts as itemized and set forth herein:

There is hereby levied for the Revenue Year 2006 for the costs of Emergency and Rescue Crews and Equipment of the Broadlands - Longview Fire Protection District, as appropriated for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2006 and ending March 31, 2007, the following amounts as itemized and set forth herein:

For the Costs of Emergency and Rescue Crews and Equipment	<u>\$8,887.00</u>

which amounts total \$8,887.00, and said amount is, and a rate sufficient to produce the same is, hereby levied against all the taxable property within said Fire Protection District as the same is equalized and assessed for the purposes of defraying the expenses of said Fire Protection District for the revenue year 2006, payable in 2007.

This ordinance shall be in full force an effect from and after its adoption as provided by law. The

Secretary of this District is directed to file a copy of this Levy Ordinance with the County Clerks of the Champaign and Douglas Counties.
