An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for Champaign Township, Champaign County, Illinois, for the year 2006, collectable in the year 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Champaign Township, Champaign County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS and no/100 (\$135,400) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the township as that property is assessed and equalized in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with law, for such purposes as:

GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUND

for the year 2007/2008.

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Champaign Township Road District, Champaign County, Illinois, for the year 2006, collectable in the year 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Champaign Township, County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Champaign Township Road District on December 12, 2006 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of THREE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS and no/100 (\$318,000) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the road district as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the road district as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with law, for such purposes as:

for the year 2007/2008.




