

ORDINANCE 2006-10

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL TOWNSHIP
PURPOSES FOR THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN TOWNSHIP,
CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
FOR THE TAX YEAR 2006, COLLECTIBLE IN 2007**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN
TOWNSHIP, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of four hundred and seventy-five thousand, three hundred and sixteen dollars and no cents (\$475,316.00) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law for such purposes:

General Town Fund
General Assistance Fund
Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund
Social Security Fund

for the year 2007.

Section 2. That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

Section 4. That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.


Section 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.




**TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN

WITH THE TRUTH IN TAXATION ACT**

LINDA A. ABERNATHY, Supervisor of the TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN,
hereby certifies that,

1. On November 21, 2006, the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of the City of Champaign determined the amounts of money estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the fiscal year 2007-2008 upon the taxable property within the Town of the City of Champaign, a total aggregate amount which is more than 105% of the extensions, exclusive of election costs, for the preceding year;

2. On December 12, 2006, the annual tax levy was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of the City of Champaign in a total aggregate amount which is more than 105% of the extensions, exclusive of elections costs, for the preceding year;

3. The Town of the City of Champaign has complied in all respects with the provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-95 of "The Truth in Taxation Law."

RESOLUTION 2006 - 09
A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE AMOUNTS OF MONEY
NECESSARY TO BE RAISED BY THE TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, an Act to provide procedures for the public notice and hearing on tax levy increases, as adopted by the General Assembly of the state of Illinois, became effective on July 29, 1981; and

WHEREAS, said Act requires taxing districts, including the **TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN**, to disclose by publication and hold a public hearing on their intention to adopt an aggregate levy in amounts more than 105% of the property taxes extended or estimated to be extended upon the levy of the preceding years; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of said Act requires the corporate authority of each taxing district, not fewer than twenty (20) days prior to the adoption of its aggregate levy, to determine the amounts of money, exclusive of any portion of that levy attributable to the cost of conducting any election required by the general election law, estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for that year upon the taxable property in its district; and

WHEREAS, if the estimate of the corporate authority required to be made as provided in Section 4 of said Act is more than 105% of the preceding year, exclusive of election costs, Section 6 of said Act requires the corporate authority to give public notice of and hold a public hearing on its intent to adopt a levy which is more than 105% of the extensions, exclusive of the election costs, for the preceding year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF THE CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of the City of Champaign, Champaign County, Illinois, hereby determines that the amounts of money, exclusive of any portion of the aggregate tax levy attributable to the cost of conducting an election required by the general election law, be and the same is hereby estimated to be \$474,488 which said amount is to be raised by taxation for the current year upon the taxable property in the Town of the City of Champaign.

2. That the aggregate amount of property taxes for the Town of the City of Champaign, extended upon the levy of the preceding year, exclusive of election costs, was \$422,281.


3. That the estimate of \$474,488 to be levied for the current year is 107.01% of the \$422,281 extended upon the levy for the preceding year, exclusive of election costs.

4. That a public hearing on the Board of the Town Trustees' intention to adopt an aggregate levy in an amount more than 105% of the property taxes extended through the final aggregate levy, exclusive of election costs, of the preceding year shall be scheduled for December 12, 2006 at 7 pm.


5. That notice of the proposed levy and the planned public hearing shall be published in *The News-Gazette* between November 29 and December 5, 2006.
