**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE  
FOR HERITAGE COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #8  
TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING**

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax increase for Heritage CUSD #8 for 2007 will be held on October 18, 2006 at 6:45 p.m. at the Homer School Building.

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Andrew Larson, Superintendent, 206 E. Diller Street, Broadlands, IL 61816, (217)834-3393.

II. The corporate and special purpose taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$2,291,083.

The proposed corporate and special property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$2,493,500. This represents a 8.83% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 were \$422,199.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2007 are \$426,000. This represents a 90% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$2,713,282. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$2,914,500. This represents a 7.60% increase over the previous year.
