ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

An Ordinance levying taxes for the Ludlow Township, Champaign County, State of Illinois, for the tax year 2006 collectible in 2007.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of Ludlow Township, Champaign County, State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the sum of \$102,559.00 is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the township as that property is assessed and equalized for the currant year, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- A. GENERAL TOWN FUND
- B. GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUND
- C. CEMETERY FUND







ORDINANCE NO. 10-19-06-2

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Ludlow Township Road District, Champaign County, State of Illinois, for the tax year 2006, collectable in 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Ludlow Township, Champaign County, State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Ludlow Township Road District on October 19, 2006, does hereby determine and declare that the sum of one hundred eleven thousand three hundred four Dollars (\$111,304.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- A. GENERAL ROAD FUND
- B. PERMANENT ROAD FUND
- C. CONSTRUCTION OF REPAIR OF BRIDGES AT JOINT EXPENSE OF COUNTY for the year 2007.


