

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Mahomet Public Library District of the County of Champaign and State of Illinois shall levy an additional tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property within said District, for building and maintenance purpose, subject to the right of the electors in said District to petition and require an election concerning the imposition of such additional tax, pursuant to 75 ILCS 16/35-5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that within fifteen (15) days from the date of adoption of the ordinance, it shall be published in the Mahomet Citizen, a newspaper of general circulation in the Mahomet Public Library District and is effective immediately upon adoption.

ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING PROPERTY TAX FOR  
MAHOMET PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN  
STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING  
THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2006 AND ENDING  
THE 30<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JUNE, 2007

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Mahomet Public Library District, in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2006 pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 2006-2) for said Library District for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2007, and

WHEREAS, said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published as provided by law after its passage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MAHOMET PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the total sum of THREE-HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$380,000) composed as follows:






