**TAX LEVY ORDINANCE**

**MULTI-TOWNSHIP ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

**ORDINANCE No. \_\_\_\_\_**

An Ordinance levying taxes for all assessment purposes for OGDEN-STANTON MULTI-TOWNSHIP ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2006, collectable in 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of OGDEN-STANTON MULTI-TOWNSHIP ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND SEVENTY-NINE AND 00/100-----Dollars (\$23,079.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Multi-Township Assessment District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Multi-Township Assessment District as required by statute, for the year 2006.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

SECTION 3: That the Clerk shall make and file with the County Clerk of said County of Champaign, on or before the last Tuesday of December, a duly certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
