CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the Paxton-Buckley-Loda Community Unit School District No. 10, and as such presiding officer, I certify that the Levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all aspects in compliance, with the provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

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**NOTICE OF ADOPTED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR PAXTON-BUCKLEY-
LODA COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #10**

- I. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$5,308,505.

The adopted corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$5,734,800. This represents a 7.433% increase over the previous year.
- II. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2005 were \$698,493.


The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 are \$520,530. This represents a 25.478% decrease over the previous year.
- III. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$6,006,998.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$6,255,330. This represents a 3.969% increase over the previous year.
