ORDINANCE NO. 3

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Pesotum Road District, Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2006, collectable in 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Pesotum Township, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
