TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE  
RANTOUL-LUDLOW MULTI ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

     4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."


