 for St. Joseph Community Consolidated School District No.

- II. The corporate and special purpose taxes extended for 2006
 were \$2,141,964.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to
 be levied for 2007 are \$2,452,650. This represents an increase of
 14.5% over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service for 2006 was
 \$386,829.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$407,275.
 This represents an increase of 5.3% over the previous year.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were
 \$2,528,793.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are
 \$2,859,925. This represents an increase of 13.1% over the previ-
 ous year.
