An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for St. Joseph Township,
Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2006 , collectable in 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph Township,
Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of two hundred fifty-three thousand, five hundred fifty-one
Dollars (\$253,551) are hereby levied upon all
property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to
meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted
by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

General Assistance Fund

Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund,

Library Fund

for the year 2006.



Road District, Champaign County, Illinois.

On November 14, 2006 at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph Township, Champaign County, Illinois, the Highway Commissioner of said Township appeared and requested consent in writing by the trustees to the levy of a rate greater than .125 percent of the value as equalized by the Illinois Department of Revenue of the property in said Township for road purposes and for the determination of the amount of such additional levy.

We, the undersigned, being a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees of said Township, County and State, after considering such request from the commissioner and after the question had been submitted to a vote of the trustees at said meeting, and it appearing from such vote that a majority of the Board of Trustees voted in favor of authorizing the commissioner to levy a rate greater than .125 percent of the value so assessed, for road purposes in said Township did vote to authorize said commissioner to levy an additional rate of .04 percent in addition to .125 percent making a total rate of .1650 percent of the full and fair cash value of the taxable property in said Township of St. Joseph for road purposes.


