TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THOMASBORO FIRE PROTECTION
DISTRICT FOR THE REVENUE YEAR 2006

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of **THOMASBORO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**, in **Champaign** County, State of Illinois:

Section 1: That the sum of **\$144,000.00** is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the **THOMASBORO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT** as that property is assessed and equalized for the current year, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- A. GENERAL FUND**
- B. LIABILITY FUND**
- C. AUDIT FUND**

Section 2: That the amount levied for each such object and purpose shall be as follows:

Section 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
