ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING MUNICIPAL TAX FOR CAMARGO TOWNSHIP DISTRICT LIBRARY OF THE COUNTIES OF DOUGLAS AND CHAMPAIGN, STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE 1st DAY OF JULY, 2007 AND ENDING THE 30th DAY OF JUNE, 2008

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Camargo Township District Library, in the Counties of Douglas and Champaign, State of Illinois, did on the 20th day of August, 2007 pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 082020071) for said Library District for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published as provided by law after its passage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CAMARGO TOWNSHIP DISTRICT LIBRARY, IN THE COUNTIES OF DOUGLAS AND CHAMPAIGN, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the total sum of ONE HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$112,450.00) composed as follows: The sum of SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$79,800.00), being the amount deemed required for the necessary corporate purposes of Camargo Township District Library, Douglas and Champaign Counties, Illinois; the sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), being required for the payment of employer contributions of the Camargo Township District Library to the Social Security Fund; the sum of SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$7,000.00), being required for the payment of employer contributions of the Camargo Township District Library to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00),

being required for the payment of the professional opinion of an accountant and other auditing expenses from an Audit Fund; the sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of payments of premiums due for the purchase of liability insurance, property damage (fire) insurance, risk management and loss control, and legal fees for defending or otherwise protecting itself against liability from a Liability Fund; the sum of TEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$10,600.00), being required for the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment from a Maintenance Fund, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all taxable property within this Library District according to the full fair value as established and ascertained for State and County purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008 and the Board of Trustees of the Camargo Township District Library having on the 20th day of August, 2007 duly passed and adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008 and said Ordinance having been duly published in a newspaper of general circulation within this Public Library District, this Board finds that the specific purposes and the specific amounts provided for in said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, are required to be levied for the necessary purposes of the Camargo Township District Library.

Section 2: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Camargo Township District Library is hereby directed to file a

duly certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerks of Douglas and Champaign Counties, Illinois, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2007; and said County Clerks are hereby authorized and directed to extend the said tax so levied by this Ordinance, according to law, against all taxable property within the Camargo Township District Library. The Secretary of Camargo Township District Library shall also file on or before the last Tuesday of December 2007, duly certified copies of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and this Ordinance with the Camargo Township District Library where they shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the Camargo Township District Library for 2007 will be held on November 19, 2007 at 7:30 P.M. at the library, 14 North Main Street, Villa Grove, IL 61956-1517.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended for 2006 were \$88,287.51.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$112,450.00. This represents a 27.4% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 were \$0.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2007 are \$0. This represents a 0% increase over the previous year.

IV The total property taxes extended for 2006 were \$88,287.51.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$112,450.00. This represents a 27.4% increase over the previous year.

**ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO LEVY ADDITIONAL TAX OF
.02% FOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIRS AND ALTERATIONS OF
LIBRARY BUILDINGS AND EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, The Illinois Public Library District Act authorizes the corporate authorities of a public library district to levy an additional .02% tax for the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment in accordance with the provisions of said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Camargo Township Public Library District has determined that such an additional tax is necessary and advisable and therefore propose to levy such an additional .02% tax for such above-stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Library Trustees:

1. That the corporate authorities of said public library district levy an additional tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property in the Camargo Township Public Library District for the current levy year for the purpose of the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment as provided in the Illinois Public Library District Act;

2. That within fifteen (15) days after adoption of this Ordinance by the corporate authorities, this Ordinance, preceded by the Notice hereinafter described, shall be published in the **VILLA GROVE NEWS**, the same being a newspaper published in the District, and if no petition, signed by a number of electors of the District being not less than 10% or more of the total number of registered voters in the District, asking that the question of levying such a .02% tax be submitted to the electors of the District, is filed with the Secretary of the District within thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this Ordinance, preceded by the notice conforming with the provisions of the Illinois Public Library District Act, then the District shall be authorized to levy said tax.



**NOTICE OF INTENT TO LEVY ADDITIONAL
.02% TAX AND RIGHT TO FILE PETITION**

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to a certain Ordinance, set forth immediately following this Notice, adopted August 20, 2007, the Corporate Authorities of the Camargo Township Public Library District have proposed to levy an additional tax of .02% as stated in such Ordinance for the purpose of the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment.

In addition, notice is hereby given that if a Petition signed by not less than 280 electors of the District (being equal to 10% of the number of registered voters in the District in the last preceding general election) requesting that the question of levying such a .02% tax be submitted to the electors of said District within thirty (30) days of the date of publication hereof and of the Ordinance, the question of levying such a .02% tax shall be certified to the proper election authority who shall submit the question at an election to be held on February 5, 2008, if such a question can be and is presented at such election; and otherwise at the next election at which such a question could be presented under the general election laws. A form of Petition is available to any person requesting one from the Secretary of said District.

**ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO LEVY ADDITIONAL TAX OF

WHEREAS, The Illinois Public Library District Act authorizes the corporate authorities of a public library district to levy an additional .02% tax for the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment in accordance with the provisions of said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Camargo Township Public Library District has determined that such an additional tax is necessary and advisable and therefore propose to levy such an additional .02% tax for such above-stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Library Trustees:

1. That the corporate authorities of said public library district levy an additional tax of .02% of the value of all taxable property in the Camargo Township Public Library District for the current levy year for the purpose of the maintenance, repairs and alterations of library buildings and equipment as provided in the Illinois Public Library District Act;

2. That within fifteen (15) days after adoption of this Ordinance by the corporate authorities, this Ordinance, preceded by the Notice hereinafter described, shall be published in the **VILLA GROVE NEWS**, the same being a newspaper published in the District, and if no petition, signed by a number of electors of the District being not less than 10% or more of the total number of registered voters in the District, asking that the question of levying such a .02% tax be submitted to the electors of the District, is filed with the Secretary of the District within thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this Ordinance, preceded by the notice conforming with the provisions of the Illinois Public Library District Act, then the District shall be authorized to levy said tax.
