TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

1-07-17

WHEREAS, the 'Board of Trustees' of the 'Village' of Foosland in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 9th day of April A. D. 19-2007 pass the annual appropriation bill for said 'Village' for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of May A. D. 192007, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$30,900.00 Dollars, which said appropriation bill was duly 'posted' on the 11th day of April A. D. 192007 Now, therefore

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR

BE IT ORDAINED by the 'Board of Trustees' of the 'Village' of Foosland Illinois:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said Village of Foosland subject to taxation for the year, A. D. 192007

the total sum of \$1,520.55 Dollars, for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Village of
Foosland, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I
certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all
respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in
Taxation" law.
