LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, did on the _____ day of December, 2007, the aggregate amount of which is ascertained to be in the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND NO HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$726,645.00):

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY The Board of Trustees of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, that there be and there is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Gifford, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2007, the sum of SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY AND NO HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$63,130.00) for the following specific purposed itemized in said Appropriation Ordinance on the following sums:




