An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for HENSLEY Township,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of HENSLEY Township,
CHAMPAIGN County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED

Dollars (\$ 58,500) are hereby levied upon all
property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to
