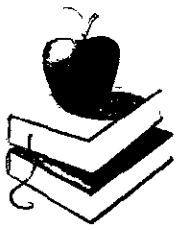

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## NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR HERITAGE COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #8 TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax increase for Heritage CUSD #8 for 2007 will be held on October 17, 2007 at 6:45 p.m. at the Homer School Building.

II. The corporate and special purpose taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$2,364,118.

The proposed corporate and special property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$2,510,000. This represents a 6.17% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 were \$380,763.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2007 are \$382,377. This represents a .42% increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$2,744,881. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$2,884,377. This represents a 5.10% increase over the previous year.
