TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Homer in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did heretofore duly adopt an Annual Appropriation Ordinance for said Village for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of May 2007 and extending to the 30th day of April, 2008, which said Appropriation Ordinance was duly adopted and published within the time and in the manner required by statute; and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$809,588.00 is the total amount appropriated in said Annual Appropriation Ordinance and the corporate authorities of said Village have now determined the amount to be collected from the property tax levy for said fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$130,000.00 be and the same is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property in said Village subject to taxation for the current year. The specific amount levied for the various purposes being hereafter placed in a column under the heading "Amount Levied" and being placed opposite the specific purposes for which said levies are made and opposite the amount appropriated for said purposes by said Appropriation Ordinance.

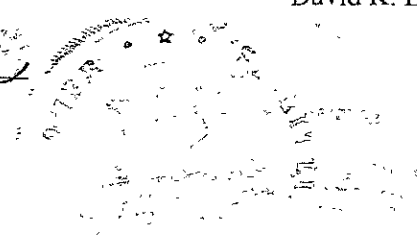



TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Village of Homer, Illinois,
, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I
certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all
respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in
Taxation" law.
