- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 were 0.0%.
- The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2007 are \$0.0. This represents a 0.0% increase over the previous year.
- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2006 were \$416,738.48.
- The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2007 are \$460,000.00. This represents a 10.38% increase over the previous year.
