TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 5-08

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for St. Joseph Township,
Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2007 , collectable in 2008.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph Township,
Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of two hundred sixty-six thousand, two hundred eleven
Dollars (\$266,211) are hereby levied upon all
property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to
meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted
by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

General Town Fund

General Assistance Fund

Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund,

Library Fund

for the year 2007.



I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of St. Joseph Township Road District, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for St. Joseph Road District Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2007, collectable in 2008.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of St. Joseph Township, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of St. Joseph Road District on November 13th, 2007 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of one hundred forty-seven thousand, five hundred seventy-four dollars (\$147,574) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

- Joint Bridge Fund
- Building and Equipment Fund


SECTION 4: That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for St. Joseph Road District.




