ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING MUNICIPAL TAX FOR  
THE TOLONO PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN,  
STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING  
THE 1st DAY OF JULY, 2007 AND ENDING  
THE 30th DAY OF JUNE, 2008

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Tolono Public Library District, in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 3rd day of July, 2007 pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 2007-070301) for said Library District for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published as provided by law after its passage; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOLONO PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the total sum of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$262,000.00) composed as follows, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all taxable property within this Library District according to the full fair value as established and ascertained for State and County purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008 and the Board of Trustees of the Tolono Public Library District having on the 3rd day of July, 2007 duly passed and adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008 and said Ordinance having been duly published in a newspaper of

general circulation within this Public Library District. This Board finds that the specific purposes and the specific amounts provided for in said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, are required to be levied for the necessary purposes of the Tolono Public Library District:





spinal taps, hearing tests and much more and just keeps right on fighting. It depends on how well he recovers from this surgery as to when his next round of chemo will start.

His next two rounds of chemo will consist of six days in the hospital and then three to four weeks of recovery. Between the next two rounds of chemo, he will also undergo another surgery for a G-tube since Camden typically doesn't eat. Right now he is receiving his nutrition through his IV.

Once the next two rounds of chemo are completed, Camden should be able to return home on oral chemo that Jenny will administer through his G-tube along with formula for his nutrition. Weekly trips will have to be made to St. Jude's for lab work, and a once-a-month physical will also be necessary.

Recently Camden lost his hair, eyelashes and most of his eyebrows. Jenny says she never thought she would notice something as small as his eyelashes falling out. She also says that he can lose whatever he needs to because that isn't what makes him who he is.

"He's still special, handsome and precious no matter what," says Camden's mom. Each step they take from July 1 forward is all uncharted territory as no other child Camden's age with the same metastatic medulla blastoma has ever gone through his treatment regimen. From here on out, it is even more unpredictable than before.

Jenny recalls telling her sister Gwen that she was "that mom." The one in the beginning of this story saying, "I'm not going to make Camden an experiment or robot or drag him through the ringer just to keep him alive....but when

you know that it's life or death for your baby, and that's actually a possibility then....I can tell you from experience, you want more....whatever they can do...whatever they can do to save your baby another day...to hear him laugh...to see that smile...to just watch him sleep. My God, this is so tough."

Faith, family and prayers are what get them through these troubled times every step of the way.

Jenny says they can't thank enough people enough times for all they have done for her family emotionally, financially and spiritually. The love and support that has been shown to them is overwhelming, and they are forever grateful.
