ORDINANCE NO. 07-2

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE FOR THE  
TOLONO PARK DISTRICT IN CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS  
FOR 2007-2008

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Tolono Park District in Champaign County, Illinois, did, on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, A.D., 2007, pass the Combined Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Tolono Park District in Champaign County, Illinois for the fiscal year beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, A.D., 2007 and ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, A.D., 2008 after due Notice and hearing.

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of said Park District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with law, the Commissioners do hereby find and declare that there will be required to be raised by general taxation the amounts hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOLONO PARK DISTRICT IN CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That there be, and there is hereby, levied and assessed upon all the taxable property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of said Park District for the revenue year A.D., 2007-2008, the total sum of \$100,500.00 for the following specific purposes, and in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE


- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVY**

The Tolono Park District in Champaign County, Illinois will hold a public hearing on the proposed tax levy at 7p.m. on Monday, September 17, 2007 at the offices of Unit School District #7, 404 North Central Avenue, Tolono, Illinois.

In 2006 the aggregated amount of property taxes (exclusive of election costs) extended on behalf of the Park District was \$72,182.23. The estimate of the aggregate amount of property taxes (exclusive of election costs) proposed to be levied for the current year is \$100,500.

The estimate levy for 2007 is 39.23094% more than the extended tax.
