# TAX LEVY ORDINANCE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No \_\_\_\_\_

An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for Urbana Township,  
Champaign County, Illinois, for the tax year 2007, collectable in 2008

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Urbana Township,  
Champaign County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of One Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand  
Dollars (\$ 138,000 ) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed  
and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted  
by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of URBANA TOWNSHIP, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check One of the Choices Below:

- 1) The taxing district's aggregate levy did exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, the district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing, meeting the requirements of the "Truth in Taxation Law."

- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the "Truth in Taxation Law."

SECTION 4: That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for Urbana Township Road District.

SECTION 5: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
