



# Champaign County Voter Registration Info



## What does this form do?

- ✓ Register you to vote
- ✓ Update your existing voter registration
- ✓ Update a name change
- ✓ Request a vote by mail ballot



## Dates and Deadlines

- This form can be used to register to vote up to 28 days before the election. After that registration must be done in person at the County Clerk's office.
- Vote by Mail requests are accepted by mail up to 5 days before the election. You can request a vote by mail application in-person at the Clerk's office up to a day before the election.
- Same Day Registration - go to a polling location up to and including Election Day to register and vote. Find a list of locations on our website.



## Vote By Mail Ballots

- ✓ Vote by mail is easy safe and secure.
- ✓ Vote by mail is available to all eligible voters.
- ✓ The Clerk's Office verifies you are a registered voter in Champaign County & will send a ballot in a secure envelope.
- ✓ Complete the ballot & mail it back to the Clerk's Office or drop it off at one of the drop box locations.
- ✓ Track your ballot on our website.
- ✓ Vote by Mail requests are accepted by mail up to 5 days before the election. You can request a vote by mail application in-person at the Clerk's office up to a day before the election.
- ✓ You can return your ballot at any of the 5 ballot drop boxes around the county. For a complete list of all drop box locations, visit the Clerk's website.

## Who Can Vote?

- ✓ Must be a United States Citizen.
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old on or before the next election. If you are 17 and will be 18 on or before the next General election, you may register and vote in the Primary.
- ✓ Reside in your election precinct (your address) for at least 30 days.
- ✓ Not be currently serving a criminal sentence. Previous convictions, parole, and registry status do not bar anyone from voting in Illinois.
- ✓ Not claim the right to vote anywhere else.



## 1<sup>st</sup> Time Voters!

If this is the first time you're voting in Champaign County, make sure you have completed Section 4 on the other side. If you do not complete Section 4, it will delay your registration and prevent you from receiving a vote by mail ballot.

Once your registration has been processed the Clerk's Office will mail you a voter registration card and you can verify your voter status and look up relevant information at [www.champaigncountyclerk.com](http://www.champaigncountyclerk.com).
